Here is a general summary of the duties:

10-hours required per week.

WEEKLY: Clean and stock lavatory on main floor and as needed.

Vacuum carpet upstairs and downstairs. Clear debris from pews. Remove trash from offices, Gibbs Hall, Parlor, etc.

BIWEEKLY: Mop tile floors in basement. Dust pews and window sills in sanctuary, Gibbs Hall, Parlor and Sunday School classrooms. Clean pews and other woodwork.

WEDDINGS / FUNERALS: Prepare sanctuary, Ladies' Parlor, Gibbs Hall, and lavatory prior to ceremony. Be available during the ceremony to assist as needed. Compensation will be provided as per schedule.
